The terms of employment must be in line with UK legislation including the national minimum wage and working time regulations. Tier 2 visa holders should also be paid the minimum salary for their visa or job: in practice this normally means £30,000 for Tier 2 General, £24,800 for the Tier 2 Intra Company Transfer short-term category and £41,500 for the long-term category.

In the UK employers must have a statutory or fair reason to dismiss the individual (conduct, capability, redundancy, retirement (about to be repealed), statutory illegality and "some other substantial reason") and must follow a set statutory fair procedure to terminate employment (or even to discipline an employee).
