There must, therefore, be only one substance, and not two kinds of substances, as Descartes argues. If can only do so because he holds onto the difference between creation and God, finite and infinite substance. For Spinoza, on the contrary, there is only one substance which is 'God or Nature'.

But the comparisons bring additional difficulties. First, to defend a comprehensive system involves refuting rivals, and the discussion of Spinoza demonstrates that refutation is difficult. Second, it is hard to see how any argument for Hegel's system could be akin to those in Spinoza and Kant given the extent of the differences between them.

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What Moder does so brilliantly in Hegel and Spinoza is to use both Hegel and Spinoza as a provocation to test, stretch and improve the thought of the other: the two philosophers get better because of the encounter Moder manufactures between them. Hegel and Spinoza, then, consists ultimately in a series of challenges that Hegelianism and Spinozism set each other and the increasingly subtle and radical lengths each form of thought will go to in order to show itself capable of meeting them.
