- Tithe/offerings should contribute at least 80% of total income
- Payroll in a large church may average 40% of budget; 60% in a small church
- Debt should be no more than 25% of budget
- Total building expense should be no more than 30% of budget
- Minimum of 10-20% of budget should go to missions outside of church
- Maintain 3-6 months of reserves

### **BUILDING THE MINISTRY BASED CHURCH BUDGET**

Calculate the total income and expenses then compare them afterwards. The church's expected expenses should not exceed its income. For you to build a better budget, it would also help if you underestimate your income and overestimate your expenses. This way, you may have extra money to use in the long run.
