In the case of Mediation, the mediator has the liberty to select any suitable method of resolve the dispute as there are no strict guidelines to follow. While in case of conciliation the conciliator is bound to follow the process given under the Arbitration and Conciliation Act (Sections 61 to 81).

What to expect throughout the conciliation conference process

Mediation ensures confidentiality but it does not guarantee the attainment of the outcome. In contrast, arbitration gives guaranteed result, but the confidentiality of the matter is at stake and at the same time the cost of arbitration is greater than mediation.

In arbitration the two parties in controversy agree in advance to abide by the decision made by a third party called in as a mediator, whereas conciliation is less structured. Conciliation is used in labor disputes before arbitration and may also take place in several areas of the law.

Conciliation and mediation Mediation and conciliation are considered as alternative modes of dispute settlement in which a third party intervenes with the parties to help them resolve the dispute between them.

Conciliation and mediation

Conciliation and mediation can be highly similar, although the focus of the former is more on the relationship, and the latter on result. Also, because mediation is often a required step in a litigation process, the attempt at mediation, and the recorded result, even if failed, is a more formal process than conciliation.
