If your device has an SD card, you can upload files to Dropbox from there. To do so: Open the Dropbox app. Open the Dropbox folder where you'd like to store your photos. Tap the + (plus) icon at the bottom of your screen. Select Upload files. Navigate to your SD card, and tap the files you'd like to upload. Tap Upload (or Open on some devices).

No manual uploading or downloading is required The Dropbox service monitors the Dropbox folder on your computer and the Dropbox mobile apps. If there's a change—a new file or folder, or an edit to an existing file or folder—Dropbox will automatically sync those changes. No manual uploading is downloading is required.

Files uploaded to dropbox.com must be 50 GB or smaller. All files uploaded to your Dropbox must be smaller than your storage space. For example, if your account has a storage quota of 2 GB, you can upload one 2 GB file or many files that add up to 2 GB. If you are over your storage quota, Dropbox will stop syncing.

In the Dropbox app, go to Settings by either tapping the menu icon in Android and choosing Settings or, in iOS, tapping the Settings icons at the bottom of the screen. Tap Turn on Camera Upload. By default, How to Upload is set to Wi-Fi only, but if you want to enable upload at anytime, tap and choose Wi-Fi or Data Plan.

In your Dropbox, navigate to where you want to upload your files. Click the Upload button in the toolbar near the Search field. Or, right-click in the file list area and choose Upload... In the Upload to Dropbox dialogue box, click Choose Files.

Upload the image you want to crop. After your image is loaded, you can choose the cropping options from the top navigation of the canvas. Clicking on "Apply" will apply the changes to the preview. On the side, you can choose the format to save your file in, as well as the filename, quality or DPI (optional).
