Use Cmd/Ctrl+C to copy the selection Use the lasso to draw a loose circle around the part of the photo that you want to move. You'll want to leave extra room, and make the circle fairly large. This is easy to take off later, but if you have to add more on, you can't do anything except start over.

Two Quick and Easy Photoshop Head-Swapping Techniques

Take lots of images. Make sure you take enough shots so that every point in the scene or on your subject is in focus in at least one of the photos. Ideally, you'll want the depth of field to overlap from one image to the next. In general, the more photos you take, the better the results you can expect.

How To Focus Stack Images In Photoshop

(Mac OS) Choose Photoshop > Preferences > Guides, Grid, & Slices. For Color, choose a color for the guides, the grid, or both. If you choose Custom, click the color box, choose a color, and click OK. For Style, choose a display option for guides or the grid, or both.
