The test is pass/fail, and requires a 70% or higher to pass. Those who pass will face a tool recognition test and an interview. High scorers improve their chances to be called for an interview.

The math portion covers algebra and functions with a total of 33 questions that must be answered within 46 minutes.. Applicants must take and pass the Elevator Industry Aptitude Test (administered by the National Elevator Industry Educational Program) with a minimum score of 70. The test was developed and validated by Performance Associates of Memphis, TN. A testing fee of \$25 must be paid at the time of testing.
