All non-chronological reports describe the way things are and give the audience an understanding of the things in question. They classify the information into different categories, for instance, climate or appearance. They employ a logical structure instead of a temporal one, and that is why they are referred to as non chronological reports.

For example, things like explanations and instructions are all written in time order (eg. explaining the Water Cycle) - but a non-chronological report includes various facts about a single topic.
