Excellent nymph fishing precedes the hatch and a good spinner fall often follows it, at around 5 or 6 p.m., and lasts until nearly sunset. My personal-best fly fishing catch during Hendrickson time on Owasco Inlet was a 25-inch rainbow that took an emerger pattern and most of my fly line for a long downstream run before surrendering.

Coping with Current: How to Fish Nymphs in Slow, Medium ...

If fishing just one nymph I use 7' of 4lb to 5lb fluorocarbon, with a 2' to 3' tippet of 2lb or 3lb fluorocarbon. I use this step down to aid casting slightly with a thicker butt section and so that if I break off I'm not leaving yards of line behind. If fishing small streams the butt section can be shortened accordingly.

Upstream Nymphing - River Flyfishing

Nymphs are flies that are in between the larvae and full adult stage. They're a bit lower in the water column and will soon be hatching on the surface. Nymph fishing can be done in a variety of water, but streams and rivers are the best options. You'll use your regular 8 to 9 foot rod with an indicator, split shot and smaller fly.
