The second table adds two variables to illustrate what to do when there are more variables than can fit across the page.

Regression table overview. Regression tables can be constructed using the apa.reg.table function. The constructed table includes the unstandardized regression coefficient (b with CI), standardized regression coefficient (beta with CI), semi-partial correlation squared ( $(sr^2)$  with CI), the correlation ( $(r)$ ), and the overall fit of the model (indexed by  $(R^2)$  with CI).
