In a running fight with the British task force composed of the battleship HMS Duke of York, a heavy cruiser, three light cruisers, and nine destroyers, the Scharnhorst was sunk with the loss of more than 1,900 crewmen. The Battle of the North Cape was fought in limited visibility, with the Scharnhorst firing blindly for much of the action.

At 16.40 Belfast 10 miles astern, was ordered to illuminate Scharnhorst with star shells. However, Scharnhorst could not be seen from Duke of York. The latter then fired her own star shell which burst precisely beyond Scharnhorst, silhouetting her

Scharnhorst and several destroyers sortied from Norway to attack a convoy, but British naval patrols intercepted the German force. During the Battle of the North Cape (26 December 1943), the Royal Navy battleship HMS Duke of York and her escorts sank Scharnhorst. Only 36 men were rescued, out of a crew of 1,968.
